**11.) Old/New Business**


The Committee commented on the musical and all the work that Nick LaPete and Barbara Emerick put into the production to ensure its success.

There will not be a School Committee meeting on April 16, 2013.





It was noted that the track field and the tennis courts are now open and available to the public.




