5. Superintendent's Update

Mr. Carney reminded the public that there is an upcoming PSG golf tournament. He noted that Whitin Elementary was again recognized by the Commonwealth as being a Green School and won the Sustainability Award (Outstanding Environmental Education Program with a Proven Track Record of 5 or more years!). 6. FY16 and FY17 Budget Updates

Town meeting is scheduled for May 10, 2016.

The Massachusetts House has voted to increase Chapter 70 funding for Uxbridge by approximately \$67,000. The next vote will be by the Senate.

7. Final Vote on the FY 17 School Department Budget (A)

Ms. Keegan moved the School Committee approve an operational budget for FY17 totaling \$19,406,144. Mr. Dugan seconded the motion. The Committee voted in favor of the motion 6-0-0. The motion passed.

Ms. Keegan moved that the School Committee approve a transportation budget totaling \$1,231,665 for FY17. Mr. Dugan seconded the motion. The Committee voted in favor of the motion 6-0-0. The motion passed.

8. Superintendent's Evaluation - Report to Public

Ms. King read the Superintendent's composite evaluation. Mr. Carney rated an overall score of Proficient in all 4 major standards.

9. Old/New Business

The public was reminded that there are several district sponsored articles for the Spring Town Meeting.
