1) Completion Review: Site Plan Application for Gerry's Used Cars, 1201 State St., (Map 1/Lot 15); Used Car Lot.

The application was found to be complete with these items having been provided –

- need for number & dimensions of allowed parking spaces on the lot (22 sale vehicles)
- landscape buffer -(60 80) yards of vegetation screen 10' tall)
- interior use
- deed (land owner has signed the application making this requirement redundant)
- limit of one (1) sign wooden sign to be replaced with illuminated version illustrated
- -lighting description including low wattage and down-ward pointing beam
- letter from Orono-Veazie Water District, and
- letter from Police Chief.

K. Tableman moved, K. Carr seconded a motion to accept the application as complete, voted 5-0.

2) Public Hearing: Gerry Marshall & Representatives Site Plan Review; Used Car Lot; 1201 State St.; (map 01/ lot 15).

Hearing called to order: 7:11 PM. No public in attendance.

These items discussed with the applicants –

- roof repair
- clean-up of site
- parking allowance for 22 sale vehicles, with allowances for a "Grand Opening" week
- signage wooden sign to be replaced with illuminated version, with lighting per the Land Use Ordinance requirements.

Hearing closed at 7:19 PM.

3) Deliberation & Decision: Site Plan for Gerry's Used Cars, 1201 State St.

Moved: by C. Cronan; seconded by K. Carr to approve with the following conditions –

- "Knock Box" per requirements of Fire Dept. installed within four (4) weeks
- clean up of lot
- 60 80 yard vegetation buffer reaching 10' 15' in height paralleling May St. from the corner of the structure

3) Deliberation & Decision (cont'd.)

conditions -

- normal parking density of sales vehicles not to exceed twenty two (22) cars ("Grand Opening" exempted from this requirement for seven (7) days)
- initial wooden sign to be replaced by illuminated sign at owner's discretion. Voted: 5-0.

A discussion on public notification ensued and J. Manter will look into this matter. The Town Attorney will be consulted regarding requirements.
