### 1. CALL MEETING TO ORDER BY CHAIRMAN

A. Senior work-off program

## SELECTMEN/SEWER COMMISSIONERS MEETING - 4-3-12 (CONT'D)

Ms. Green spoke about the senior work-off program and this year they would need to increase the pay to \$8 per hour, which is minimum wage. The hours the seniors would need to work 93.75 hours to receive the \$750 tax credit. The application process starts with the seniors filling out an application, completing a CORI check and also a check is done to ensure they don't owe any outstanding taxes. The applicant is also asked to fill out something that states they are the homeowner and sign a participation agreement. Some discussion ensued about rotating the seniors so that everyone has a chance to work indoors as well. Ms. Green stated that most of the offices have the same people year after year because they have already trained the seniors. Selectman Begley asked if they are required to sign a confidentiality agreement or take ethics training? Ms. Green stated that they have not been asked to take ethics training or sign a confidentiality agreement in the past. The board did agree that it would be something they would like to add to the program policy.

**MOTION:** Selectman Winslow moved the Board of Selectmen approve the senior work-off program in an amount not to exceed \$48,750 from the overlay account, this should accommodate 65 slots at \$8 per hour with 93.75 hours worked. Selectman Begley seconded.

VOTE: 4-0-0 (Unanimous)

**MOTION:** Selectman Winslow moved to add #8 to our existing Town of Wareham Senior Citizen Tax work-off program policy that all participants shall partake in the ethics training, which is provided online by the state. Selectman Begley seconded.

VOTE: 4-0-0 (Unanimous)

**MOTION**: Selectman Winslow moved to add #9 to our existing Town of Wareham Senior Citizen Tax work-off program policy to state that all participants shall sign confidentiality agreements when working with confidential material. Selectman Slavin seconded.

VOTE: 4-0-0 (Unanimous)

**MOTION**: Selectman Winslow moved to add #10 to our existing Town of Wareham Senior Citizen Tax work-off program policy that in the event that applications exceed available slots, preference will be given to those demonstrating the most financial need. Selectman Slavin seconded.

VOTE: 4-0-0 (Unanimous)

Selectman Winslow stated that the board received an email yesterday from Chief Richard Stanley asking the board to conduct a show cause hearing.

**MOTION:** Selectman Winslow moved that the board notify Mayflower Liquors to appear for a show cause hearing on Tuesday, May 22, 2012 for the alleged violation of selling alcohol to a person under the age of 21. Selectman Slavin seconded.
