#### 7. TOWN BUSINESS

Mr. Moore stated that a resident has challenged the fees charged for a building permit

### 9. TOWN ADMINISTRATOR'S REPORT

Mr. Sullivan said that Governor Baker has released Chapter 90 Funds; the total for Wareham is \$363,034.

Mr. Sullivan stated that Police Chief's contract was voted in executive session and would like to also have the board vote on it in open session as well.

**MOTION:** Selectman Teitelbaum moved to approve the contact with the Chief of Police. Selectman Whiteside seconded.

#### VOTE: 5-0-0 (Unanimous)

Selectman Holmes asked Mr. Sullivan if he read a recent article in the newspaper regarding Hynes Field. He went on to say that the article sounded as if CEDA was going to manage that property when in fact it was owned by the Town. Mr. Sullivan

stated that CEDA was applying for a grant for the future and it will be run by the Town and not controlled by CEDA.
