

Wareham Bike Path Committee Meeting

In Attendance: Committee members Michael Langford, Dale Scott, Lois Fountain, new committee applicant Damon Howard, Friends of Wareham Pathway David Smith and Arch Williams

Minutes of the January 19th meeting were read and accepted.

It was noted that the Pathway has had several articles in various local newspapers in the past month.

Informational Meetings were held during the past month with the Zoning Board, Conservation Commission and Open Space. A tentative appointment is made with the Historical Commission for Wednesday, March 2nd.

A public meeting with the Mass. Dept of Transportation Project Development Engineers, Pamela Haznar and Robert Gregory; Town Administrator, Mark Andrews; representatives from Weston & Sampson, SRPEDD and the Bike Path Committee is set for 9 am Wednesday, March 9 in the Town Hall Cafeteria.

David, Arch and Lois attended the South Coast Regional Bikeway Summit February 15th and reported on the progress of the various towns, cities and of the East Coast Green Way Alliance.

Dale, Lois and Arch have reviewed the Website and made several suggestions. It was noted that the bike path survey seems unavailable at present. Arch has contacted SRPEDD for an updated map and will consult Matt Underhill regarding changes to the website.

Damon Howard, committee applicant, was interviewed and it was voted to recommend his appointment to the committee

Arch and Damon will develop a program to celebrate 2011 Bay State Bike Week to be held May 14th – 20th.

The next Committee meeting will be March 16, 2011 at the Multi Service Center.
