

Wareham Bike Path Committee Meeting  
January 21, 2015  
At Wareham Multi-Service Center – Room # 228

In attendance: Michael Langford, Eileen Allgor, Dale Scott, Damon Howard

Michael Langford called the meeting to order at 6:05.

Dale Scott made a motion to accept the October minutes, seconded by Damon Howard. Approved. Note: there was no quorum in November and December meeting was canceled due to the holidays.

**Survey** – Continues at 95% favorable.

**Friends group** – The Friends group paid for the shipping costs of the bike racks. SRPEDD has a program to reimburse communities for the price of the bike racks. The bike racks were installed by the Municipal Maintenance Department.

The Friends annual meeting was scheduled for January 15<sup>th</sup> but was canceled due to weather. Michael Langford was not aware of the cancellation and went to the location for the meeting – there were a few members there so they had an informal discussion. Michael thanked them for the recent payments. The Friends group will also help with the cost of the mailing for the Public Information meeting. Eileen Allgor will research the cost for certified mail then Michael Langford will inform the Friends. The Friends annual meeting will be rescheduled.

**South Coast Bikeway Alliance** – The annual summit is scheduled for March 26<sup>th</sup>, the location will either be Fall River or Westport. The SCBA has obtained non-profit status.

**Web sites** – The bike path committee will take pictures of the bike racks in the spring and send to Arch Williams for posting on the site.

**Project Initiation Form** – Michael Langford will meet with the principal of the Minot Forest Elementary School to see if the public information meeting can be held there. Once the venue and date are finalized, the abutter letters will be sent via certified mail and the presentation will be prepared. Jeff Oakes from Marion shared their presentation from their public information meeting.


**BOS** – nothing scheduled at this time.
