MRC believes preponderance of scientific comment
is that climate change is underway with likely dire
effects particularly along Wareham's Waterfront. Dick
Wheeler was encouraged to write a brief paragraph for
the proposed H. M. Plan's update stating MRC's concerns.

Al Slavin expressed disappointment there had not yet
been responses from several authorities to get certain maps,
graphs etc wanted for the H. M. P. update but believed such
info will be available by MRC's June meeting.

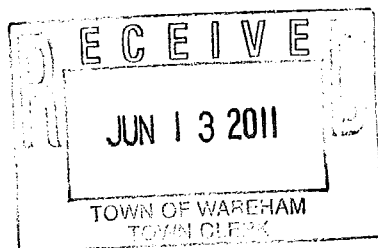
New Business: Alan distributed to MRC members a
'worksheet' he presented at B. O. S. meeting 5/10/11 during
Citizens Participation. It raises serious, rational questions:
Were State Funds to be used for beach parking purposes?
Under States pier license is the Town required to repair
and safely maintain Town pier? Should revenues from pier
activities should receive 50% of revenues, and the Community
Events Committee (CEC) should get 40% of the Town's 50%
received. No vote yet taken on these issues.

Harbormaster Report: (1) Town about to finish pier at
Bease Park. (2) Repair issues re: new Harbormaster boat
soon to be resolved. (3) New navigational guides (buoys, etc)
are going out - increased from 40 buoys to about 80.
Some are planned for We-We-antic Channel, a difficult one.
(4) Harbormaster Office taking over management of
Town summer life guards. (5) Jerry Buckminster is
preparing to clarify at Town Meeting some new reg-
s: simplified, more economical and effective. Billing
procedures that also will identify legal/judicial
mooring holders.
