**Town Hall Rubber Roof** – RFP needs to be written up by Maintenance in early August.

**Historical Society MOU** – approved by Atty Bowen, Derek Sullivan and WHS board. Worthen will sign copy.

**Old Town Offices** – Bob Ethier, Health Dept reviewing credentials for company that received bid.

Historic Preservation Restrictions – Holders needed for Fearing Tavern, Town Hall, two cemeteries, Oak Grove, American Legion. Tremont Nail to be held by Preservation MASS

**61A**, **61B** – No properties at this time.

Bike Path - Not cleared by SRPEDD. No funds can be expended without approval

**BoS Policy** – Discussion whether all town-proposed projects need to be reviewed by BoS and FinCom (per 2007 policy) before coming to CPC.

CPC Website - a few updates needed

CP2 - Dunham and Miller will prepare Committee's report, due in August.
