Articles for 2015 Spring Town Meeting:

- Oakdale Playground Request for \$45,000 from unallocated funds for Special Town Meeting to restore the Oakdale Playground. BoS and FinCom approved submission of proposal to CPC. Discussion of budget and recognition of neighborhood's in-kind efforts. Slavin moved to bring forward the Article. Joe Leggett seconded. Vote 6-0-0
- **Onset Boat Ramp** Request for \$100,000 from Harbormaster, Garry Buckminster, to restore the Onset Boat Ramp. \$67,500 additional funding will come from Bouchard Oil Spill Settlement. BoS approved submission of proposal to CPC. The \$100,000 grant would come from FY '16 estimated revenue. Slavin moved to bring forward the Article. Leggett seconded. Vote: 6-0-0.
- 3 School Tennis Courts Request for \$90,000 to create three additional tennis courts near the Middle School to be close to the existing courts. BoS and FinCom have approved submission of proposal. Suggestions to shift fire lane slightly away from the courts. Slavin moved to approve Article, to be funded by FY '16 estimated revenue. Leggett seconded. Vote: 6-0-0

Methodist Meeting House: Still need "contract ready drawings." Can

Multi Service Center Roof: Work completed.

Old Town Offices: Work completed.
