Cranberry Manor: Agreement approved by Atty. O'Donnell and signed by Carl Nagy-Koechlin of South Shore Housing. SSH is requesting \$50,000 as part of package for State. CPC requires invoice after work is completed before funds can be released. Slavin moved that Dunham receive permission from committee to discuss issue with Atty Bowen, Barrett seconded. Vote: 6-0-0
