### June 6, 2012

A meeting of the Wareham School Committee was held on Wednesday, June 6, 2012, at 7:00 p.m. in the Wareham Middle School Auditorium. Present were Geoff Swett, Cliff Sylvia, Rhonda Veugen and Mike Flaherty as well as Superintendent Dr. Rabinovitch and recording secretary, Mrs. Ruiz.

Chair Swett called the meeting to order 7:00 p.m.

#### **GOOD NEWS**

Dr. Rabinovitch shared that there were only seven days left of school and many activities are going on. Also he and Chair Swett were on the WCTV Gumbo Show.

Dr. Sylvia shared that at Senior Awards Night in excess of \$220,000 in scholarships were awarded; 87% of our graduates are going on to post secondary education.

Mrs. Veugen congratulated the students of Wareham Cooperative and WHS on graduation.

Mr. Swett mentioned the thoughtful and humorous speeches given by the Valedictorian and Salutatorian and the scholarship money this year was less because of the stock market and organizations being conservative.

## **School Committee Reports**

Mrs. Veugen announced that the Superintendent's Technology/Curriculum Advisory Committee will be meeting on Tuesday, June 12<sup>th</sup>.

(Mr. Flaherty entered the meeting at 7:08 p.m.)

Chair Swett reported that the Superintendent's Budget Advisory Committee made the necessary cuts to get to a balanced budget with the assumptions that debt exclusions and override ballot questions would not pass. Almost 2 dozen teachers were given their layoff notices and he hopes the school department will be in a position at end of July to rehire these teachers.

Tuesday, June 12<sup>th</sup> the Committee will make a presentation to the Board of Selectmen. There will be an opening statement by the Chair followed by a presentation by Dr.

Mr. Loranger stated that a goal for next year was to have youth nights for each program.

<u>Spring Report</u> – Mr. Lorangerr highlighted the sports and athletes; reviewed new programs instituted this year; SCC All Stars, SCC Honorable Mention; SCC Sportsmanship; not one student was academically ineligible to participate in sports with the increase in classes; expenses and revenue for spring sports.

Mrs. Veugen asked for a comparison of each year going forward. She also suggested including the Deans in the end of year meeting with coaches regarding increasing team GPAs.

<u>Request for Eighth Grade Waivers</u> – Mr. Loranger applied for and received MIAA approval for eighth grader waivers for Boys Cross Country, Girls Cross Country, Girls Field Hockey and Boys Golf teams.

Dr. Sylvia moved approval of the eighth grade waivers as stated, seconded by Mr. Flaherty.

<u>Acceptance of Cooperative Athletic Teams with Carver High School</u> — Mr. Loranger proposed a partnership with Wareham/Carver for Boys Ice Hockey and Wrestling.

Carver donates one of their mats on our campus until we buy our own (\$10,000 value)

Wareham keeps all money for wrestling quads and duals proceeds

Carver hires the coaches

Estimating \$4,000 in proceeds

Carver uniforms with Wareham symbol in wrestling

Division South League participation

Ice Hockey:

Wareham uniform with Carver symbol

Carver has 7 hockey players

Wareham funds hockey and Carver keeps their user fees

This is reviewed annually.
