PRELIMINARY BUSINESS

- B. <u>Informal discussion</u> Brown's Liquor signage There was no one present to take any action, no discussion.
- C. <u>Informal discussion</u> Loss of 40B unit The Board asked that the secretary place this discussion on the next agenda.
- D. <u>Informal discussion</u> Abbey Glass Mr. James Powers appeared before the Board. The Board briefly discussed the issue with the applicant. No action taken.

PUBLIC HEARINGS.

Petition #02-13 – 6 Fannie's Lane – Richard Joy – The Board discussed the applicants request and voted to grant a Special Permit for the construction of a single family dwelling with the finding that there will be no new non-conformity and that the new construction as shown on the plan will not be substantially detrimental to the neighborhood. Vote: Unanimous (5-0-0).

<u>Petition #03-13 - 41 Oak Street</u> - c/o G.A.F. Engineering, Inc. - The Board reviewed the proposed plan and voted to grant a Special Permit for the demolition of an existing single story residential dwelling and

the construction of a new single story residential dwelling and the renovation of a detached one car garage with the following conditions;

- 1. Must meet 25% building coverage.
- 2. Must meet all setbacks for residence and garage.
- 3. Garage will have no utilities other than electricity and shall not be used as or for living space.
- 4. Engineer will certify building height meets requirements of the zoning ordinance.
- 5. Parking will comply with the Town's By-Laws.
- 6. Two new sets of plans showing the above will be submitted to the Zoning Board.
- 7. Plans will be provided to the Building Department showing the above conditions.

Vote: Unanimous (5-0-0).

Petition #28-12 – 260 County Road - AT & T – The Board voted to grant a Special Permit for the installation of a one (1) panel antenna, associated antenna equipment, new fiber and coax conduits and related wireless communications equipment to an existing wireless communications facility and further, approved, per plan submitted, finding the proposed antenna replacement and upgrade conforms with the provisions of Section 540 and the upgrade will not alter the site or change the use.

Vote: Unanimous (5-0-0).

Petition #29-12 – 32 Old County Road – AT & T - The Board voted to grant a Special Permit for the installation of a one (1) panel antenna, associated antenna equipment, new fiber and coax conduits and related wireless communications equipment to an existing wireless communications facility and further, approved, per plan submitted, finding the proposed antenna replacement and upgrade conforms with the provisions of Section 540 and the upgrade will not alter the site or change the use.

Vote: Unanimous (5-0-0).

Petition #30-12 – off Kendrick Road – AT & T - The Board voted to grant a Special Permit for the installation of a one (1) panel antenna, associated antenna equipment, new fiber and coax conduits and related wireless communications equipment to an existing wireless communications facility and further, approved, per plan submitted, finding the proposed antenna replacement and upgrade conforms with the provisions of Section 540 and the upgrade will not alter the site or change the use.

Vote: Unanimous (5-0-0).

Order of Remand issued by Land Court dated October 26, 2012 16 Wankinguoah Avenue (Assessors Map 50A, Lots 5A & C5), (Petition #18-10 & #18-10A) Per the Remand order, the Board voted unanimously to reconsider under Town of Wareham Zoning By-Laws, Section 1335.

The Board voted to grant a Special Permit finding the proposed reconstruction does increase the nonconforming nature of the pre-existing structure in height but this is not considered to be substantial. Vote: Unanimous (5-0-0).

The Board asked the secretary to send the endorsed copy to Attorney Jon Witten by fax in the morning and the Town Attorney will take care of the response to the Court.
