He has already spoken to the Conservation Commission to which they have no objections. His plan calls for one (1) 55 gallon drum to be on site for waste oil which will be taken out of town. There are no plans for gasoline storage or outside storage. He has an area that would support up to 5 cars along the retaining wall plus additional parking. No repairs will be done outside. The lot is already paved with blacktop. He is would also like to be able to sell used vehicles, which would require a Class II License from the Board of Selectmen. There is existing exterior lighting from dusk to dawn on all of his buildings. On site trash is picked up on a weekly basis. Mr. Krawczyk requested that a plan be submitted detailing the parking spaces (including handicap), location of trash receptacle and sizes for signs to be erected. Mr. Mendrek is requesting Hours of Operation be 8 AM to 5 PM Monday thru Saturday. With no further discussion at this point, the following motion was made:
