Three rights of interment were sold this month.

We reviewed the notes from the Cemetery Trustees Seminar which led into a discussion on cemetery maintenance.

- A monument was broken. Ed Thayer said it was thought that the mower picked up a stone which hit the monument. No stone was found and it didn't look like a stone had hit it. Upon examining some of the other stones in the area many were found to have scrapes and chips from the mower.
