

**WASHINGTON PLANNING BOARD

Joint Site Walk**

**Minutes  
October 12, 2011**

Planning Board members and Conservation Commission members met to conduct more observational site walks on town owned lots around Washington in order to gather and verify information on the lots.

We met at the Town Hall at 9AM, gathered some assessors' equipment and the large tax maps, and drove to our first lot on South Main Street. Using a map compiled by Cook for more efficient visits, we started at TM12-180 and visited 8 lots on our list of 16.

We visited TM 12-180, TM 16-75, TM 6-83, TM 16-98, TM 16-101, TM 16-102, TM 13-35 and TM 23-31. All lots were marked with surveyors tape and after looking at the information previously gathered from property cards and maps, direct observations were made as to conditions on the ground. Schwartz took pictures and notes on the group's observations, Cook took additional observational notes on copies of the property cards.

The site visit was adjourned at 11:30 AM. The site visits will be continued on Saturday, October 15<sup>th</sup> with as many members who can join us.
