Wayland 375th Anniversary Commemoration Committee MEETING MINUTES Thursday, April 11, 2011

The meeting was opened at 7:05 PM. There was no public comment.

Wayland 375th Anniversary Forum

Ms. Antes distributed copies of the letter inviting organizations to participate in the Wayland 375 Anniversary Forum. The Committee identified additional organizations to which to send the letter including, Council on Aging, Weston Wayland Interfaith Action Group, and the Sudbury Companies Militia and Minutemen (Mr. Kennedy suggested this organization and will contact them).

Frank also suggested contacting the Civil War Enactors. The Veterans' Association in Town is another resource to tap. The Committee suggested that either Mr. Dyer or John Turchininetz, Veterans' Agent, should reach out to this group.

It was reiterated that it was important that we connect with the schools. When the new superintendent comes on board, the Committee will reach out to him.

The Committee ran through the list and identified organizations that they would personally follow up with to encourage representatives to attend the Forum.

In terms of how the forum will proceed, each committee member will facilitate the round tables and either report back, or ask a participant to report back to the entire meeting.

Announcements concerning the Forum went out to all four media outlets: eNews, Patch, Wayland Voters Network and Town Crier.

On April 27th, the Forum will be held in the Wayland Town Building in the Senior Center at 7:30.

Board of Selectmen and Summary Presentation

The Board of Selectmen has discussed adding four more members to the Committee.

A summary of the Wayland 375 Forum will be presented to the Board of Selectmen in May or June. Other committees might evolve as needed and not require a formal appointment by the Board of Selectmen.
