Brad passed out promo information for the Parade. Tomorrow, Brad and Mary will meet with the Police and Fire Chiefs and hope to get approval for the route, road closings etc. The Wayland Fire Dept. is enthusiastic. We have use of a very large flag. The Park Dept is on board. Brad will be sending an information package as a pdf to organizations and businesses in town that have expressed interest. We need a connection to the schools. Deb discussed closing activities that she and Alison are considering. The Barn Dance last June was a great success and will be repeated, with more kid activities like dance lessons and hay rides. We would encourage people to bring picnics or perhaps have food vendors.

The parade will end at the Town Building, and some activities will happen there. Parmenter and Beth Israel could sponsor tables. Other possibilities would be Strawberry Shortcake, like Parmenter did at the Opening event, Colonial Crafts people. We are looking for things that are local and free. The Mass Memories final product could be shown at the closing, other ideas discussed were gardening and cooking, showing children how to cook, have Waycam tape people cooking favorite family recipes and posting them on youtube.

Events planned for the coming weeks were discussed. There will be a Historic ballgame on May 25, sponsored by the Eastern Mass. Softball Association. They would like to place a permanent marker at the ballpark.

John Dyer had a proposal for Cochituate Village signage, and reported on the program book, which will contain political congratulations and ads. Mary asked for a list of contents.

A discussion of finances revealed that we started with \$30,000 and currently have that same amount. There will be other expenses, but do we want to use the money or return it to the town. Should we send out another letter asking for funds?
