**Parade**

Carole has contacted Gene Sabastian about having antique cars in the parade. The high school's Mr. Wayland could ride in a convertible. Brad will write the Selectmen about the parade.

The New Horizon band will probably not march the entire length of the parade. They might jump in a Five Paths or St. Ann's or they could play at the Town Building as the parade arrives. Pam will check with Wayside Inn and Mary will check with Mainstone about horses or horse and carriages.

When John joined the meeting after his Public Ceremonies Committee meeting, he said that the committee would serve as judges for the whole parade, not overseeing the bike decorations.

**Disposition of the Website**

There is no cost for the domain but there is a cost for the server if the website is maintained. Perhaps the town could pay for the cost of the server. The site could be moved to Brad's site or perhaps to the Historical Society. The content should be switched to historical from current and that could be a lot of work. The static site could be linked to other sites and contain lots of pictures and a list of celebration activities.
