PROCEDURE FOR MEETING MINUTE APPROVAL

- 1. Minute taker takes minutes at board meeting #1, then types up a draft.
- 2. Draft minutes for meeting #1 are included in pre-meeting board member packets for individual review. Nothing in the packet may be discussed with anyone until board meeting #2.
- 3. At board meeting #2, the board discusses and confirms changes to be made to draft minutes #1.
- 4. Option 1- The board is allowed at that point to approve the minutes for meeting #1 as amended.

Option 2- The minute taker can make the changes to minutes #1 after meeting #2 and send out the final draft of minutes #1 in the meeting #3 packet.

NOTES:

*Because the BOA does not meet frequently, it is more efficient to approve the minutes as amended so they may be posted to the website in a timely manner.

The minute taker can include line numbers in the draft minutes if that eases the amendment process.
