Property Inspections

During the first quarter, 8 sales inspections, 18 abatement inspections, 6 building permits, and 8 quality control visits were completed.

Full Measure and List

- Vision completed the commercial and industrial properties at the beginning of March.
- The final callback letters for 217 properties will be mailed the week of April 8th The data collector will complete callback appointments prior to beginning the third and final phase of the project.

FY 13 Abatements

To date, 12 real estate abatement applications have been processed to date along with 3 personal property applications. 18 applications are ready for Board action this evening. The remaining will be ready for BOA action by month end.

Items in progress:

- 2012 Sales Verifications letters will be mailed to all properties that staff was unable to access during the water reads for a final attempt to visit the property next week.
- Building Permits properties with building permit activity are being reviewed and owners will receive notification that staff members will be out in June to review work in progress.
- Supplemental Tax Bills all certificates of occupancy issued since June 30, 2012 are being reviewed for 50% increase in valuation. Final quality review is being completed and supplemental tax bills will be ready for BOA signature by the end of April.
