Town of Wayland Board of Assessors Monday December 16, 2013

Chair S. Rufo called the meeting to order at 7:19pm

In attendance: Chair S. Rufo, Vice-Chair J. Brodie, M. Upton, D. Hill, Z. Ventress, Director of Assessing E. Brideau and Administrative Assessor J. Marchant

Minutes:

D. Hill moved that the minutes of December 9th be approved as presented. J. Brodie seconded. Vote Passed. M. Upton and Z. Ventress abstained.

Exemption Applications:

Director Brideau recommended 15 exemption applications for approval. The applications have been reviewed and meet the criteria. J. Brodie moved to accept the Director's recommendation to approve the 15 exemption applications. M. Upton seconded. Vote Unanimous

Circuit Breaker Match Applications:

Director Brideau recommended one circuit breaker application for approval. The applicant meets the requirements and will receive a match equal to what the state gave. The BOA approved the application by signature.

FY '15 Overlay Forecast:

Z. Ventress clarified a question from a previous meeting. He was looking to find out the percent of abatements in dollars in relation to the total assessed value of the town. Is there a relationship between the abatements and the total value and does it increase in a reval year?

The board viewed and discussed the worksheet that was handed out.

The BOA reviewed the overlay suggestions previously given: M. Upton's number is \$775,000.

- J. Brodie's number is \$1,050,000.
- M. Upton explained again her reasoning for her overlay suggestion; the assessors have just completed the full list and measure so the data is more accurate than in previous years.
- J. Brodie and M. Upton both explained their FY'15 overlay budget reasoning line by line with the worksheet like they did at previous meetings.
- J. Brodie reminded the board of the significance of these numbers. If the board over budgets this number, it only affects the tax payer for the first two preliminary bills, then the tax rate gets set and the third and fourth quarter bills can be adjusted.
- Z. Ventress pointed out that the state penalizes the town if the overlay is under budgeted. The first dollars raised the following fiscal year must go towards the overlay deficit.

When reviewing the worksheet, S. Rufo clarified that in 2006 and 2009 the BOA didn't have data as accurate as it does now.

- M. Upton would not like to go above \$800,000.
- D. Hill asked if the number chosen is then given to the Finance Committee for review and input. The BOA clarified that no, the number is given to the Finance Committee by the BOA. The Finance Committee cannot change it.

Director Brideau mentioned three points: FY'15 is a reval year and it is unknown what the state may require of the town; the town center should be 100% complete for FY'15 which increases the town's exposure; and Telecom will file for abatements – though it is not known to what extent. It is written into the contracts of the town center businesses that they will file for abatements every year. They are triple net leases so the tenants have a vested interest in keeping the assessments true. For the town, there are costs associated with that including possibly needing to hire commercial appraisers during the abatement process.

\$1,000,000 was suggested as an FY'15 overlay number.

Director Brideau will have a better idea of the values when she can look at the 2013 sales.

- S. Rufo suggested that M. Upton's number is low for a reval year while thinking about the town center. The BOA discussed more options.
- Z. Ventress moved to propose the initial overlay forecast allowance for FY'15 be set at \$950,000 with a review planned for the beginning of February, 2014. Vote Unanimous.

FY '14 Tax Recap Documents for BOA review and signature

At the last BOA meeting, Director Brideau was asked to check on 3rd quarter preliminary billing and if it is an option for Wayland this year. It turns out that 3rd quarter bills are limited to valuation billing. Wayland does not qualify since the assessments were already certified.

Another option is for 3rd quarter bills to go out late, but that will create cash flow issues for the community. Director Brideau went over these options with Finance Director Brian Keveny, Acting Town Administrator John Senchyshyn, and interim Town Administrator Bob Mercier.

Director Brideau and B. Keveny met with Wayland's state representative from the DOR, Andrew Nelson, and he gave three suggestions regarding page four of the tax recap form due to the fact that the funds that were appropriated in town meeting were not in the accounts they were supposed to be in leaving a deficit of \$218,000 in the school department accounts.

Option 1- The Finance Committee makes a transfer to take care of the shortage.

Option 2- The Finance Committee votes, and if passed, the selectmen then vote to authorize \$218,000 from free cash at next town meeting.

Option 3- If options 1 and 2 do not pass, the town would have to have a special town meeting.

Those committee meetings and votes are happening tonight. If the Finance Committee does not vote option 1, it will go to option 2 at the selectman's meeting. That item is on the agenda for 9pm tonight at the Selectman's meeting.

J. Brodie asked if B. Keveny's numbers have changed. No, they have not. Director Brideau further explained the state's point of view with regard to Wayland.

D. Hill asked, since the vote at town meeting stated that the money come from the school funds, is it possible for the money to come from them instead of the finance committee? Director Brideau stated no, the state specified that the money be handled this way.

Cherry Karlson, the Finance Committee's liaison to the BOA, then came to the BOA meeting to report that the Finance Committee voted for option 2 and their meeting is in recess until the selectman's vote tonight. She further explained that the money will come from taxes regardless of the option chosen and the tax rate will remain the same. The only difference between option 1 and 2 is that the money will come from either the 2nd

half of FY'14 or it will be the first dollar raised in FY'15. By having the item on the agenda at town meeting, the residents will get a chance to speak on the issue.

The BOA discussed the events that occurred last week with regard to the various tax recap sheets that were generated.

Since the BOS won't vote until after 9pm, nothing can be done at this point in the meeting regarding the tax recap docs.

J. Brodie moved to approve the letter to the state to approve the overlay amount for FY '14 as \$614,726.80. M. Upton seconded. Vote: 4 in favor, D. Hill unable to vote.

Z. Ventress moved to sign the schedule OL-1 overlay worksheet for FY'14 dated 12/16/13 at 3:19pm. M. Upton seconded. The BOA signed the document.
