Status of Tax Collector request to Abate Personal Property and Motor Vehicle Excise

- Z. Pierce, Tax Collector/Treasurer is still working on the personal property request and has sent follow up letters to property owners. She has put together a packet showing what steps she has taken regarding the excise request and provided new documentation to the BOA. In addition, she reached out to other communities to see how they handle the issue.
- Z. Ventress asked if the list provided was cross- referenced to current residents as a means to verify accuracy. The Board discovered discrepancies during their review of the list when comparing Wayland's list to Kelly and Ryan's list. The board agreed this topic was not ready for any action tonight.
