Board of Selectmen Meeting Minutes April 9, 2010

Attendance: S. Correia, T. Fay, J. Nolan, S. Pope
Also Present: Town Administrator F. Turkington

Chair J. Nolan called the meeting of the Board of Selectmen to order at 8:03 a.m. in the Conference Room of the Selectmen's Office.

J. Nolan paused to note the passing of former Selectman Marcy Crowley, who served from 1975 to 1999, as well as serving as a member of other town boards and commissions and several regional transportation planning and environmental groups. The family has requested the use of the courtyard behind the Town Building to conduct a memorial service on Saturday, April 10, 2010, at 2:00 p.m. under a tent to be erected at the expense of the family. He noted that this request was not dissimilar from requests from organizations to hold events on town property and noted the occasional wedding ceremony performed on town property. T. Fay moved, seconded by S. Pope, to permit the use of town property for the memorial service for Marcy Crowley on Saturday, April 10, 2010. YEA: S. Correia, T. Fay, J. Nolan, S. Pope. NAY: none. ABSENT: M. Tichnor. Adopted 4-0.

The family also requested a one-day liquor license for the catering business hired to provide refreshments following the service. T. Fay moved, seconded by S. Pope, that the Board grant a one-day liquor license from 12:00 noon to 8:00 p.m. on Saturday, April 10, 2010, for alcoholic beverages on the grounds of the Town Building in conjunction with the memorial service for Marcy Crowley to Peppers Catering of Northborough, Massachusetts. YEA: S. Correia, T. Fay, J. Nolan, S. Pope. NAY: none. ABSENT: M. Tichnor. Adopted 4-0.

Town Administrator F. Turkington gave an update on the flood recovery efforts in the Squirrel Hill Road, Rolling Lane and Old Farms Road neighborhoods, as well as the status of clean-up and planned restoration of the library and Public Safety Building. He advised that Route 20 was opened both ways on Wednesday (April 7), Sherman's Bridge Road was opened on Thursday (April 6) at 7:00 a.m., and transportation service to Pelham Island Road would be suspended at 9:00 a.m. (April 9), as the road was now open to passenger vehicles. All other roads are open except River Road and Water Row.

S. Pope moved, seconded by S. Correia, to adjourn the meeting of the Board of Selectmen at 8:13 a.m. YEA: S. Correia, T. Fay, J. Nolan, S. Pope. NAY: none. ABSENT: M. Tichnor. Adopted 4-0.
