Board of Selectmen Meeting Minutes April 11, 2012

Chair T. Fay called the meeting of the Board of Selectmen to order at 7:18 p.m. in the Gymnasium of the Wayland Middle School and reviewed the agenda for the public.

A2. Public Comment There was no public comment.

A3. Discuss any Issue Related to Articles to be Considered at Annual Town Meeting; Review Errata and Supplemental Information The Board discussed Article 11. The Board of Public Works voted earlier in the evening to support the access road restriction adopted by the Board of Selectmen on April 9. George Harris, 8 Holiday Road, provided modified language for Article 19 to clarify that the boards and officials involved with tax recapitulation will collectively hold the public hearing on the estimated tax rate. The language addresses the concerns of the Board of Selectmen and the Board of Assessors. It was the consensus of the Board to recommend that citizens approve the article as revised. The Board reviewed the handouts, including Article 27 amended language and petitioner's motion under Article 28.
