Board of Selectmen Meeting Minutes June 17, 2013

whether it made sense to allow tree-clearing and other activities contemplated in the agreement prior to transfer of the property, citing a lack of recourse should the transfer not occur and the perception that the agreement bypasses the conditions of the project as determined by other town boards. It was the consensus of the Board to consider a license limited to ground-breaking and other similar activities for the tentative event on June 29. The Town Counsel was instructed to contact Habitat for Humanity to determine whether such a license would be agreeable, and to present it to the Board at its meeting on June 24, 2013.
