BUDGET FY 13 BOARD

	There is a meeting with the Personnel Board on November 21 st to discuss the COA board's recommendation to change to a full-time director from a co-director position in light of JoAnn's announced retirement.
DISCUSSION	Some line items in the current budget are unrealistic and there is more money in the transportation line than is needed. It was agreed to recommend taking \$3,000 from the transportation line for equipment. If money cannot be transferred from transportation, some money could be used to repair the van. New vans can be purchased through the MWRTA with 80 percent of the cost paid by the state and 20 percent by the town. Lorraine Greiff might be willing to lead that effort.
	Betsy W mentioned that the Wayland Business Association could be asked for funds for equipment.
ACTION	It was moved, seconded, and voted to recommend a single full-time department head (Soule/Onello).
7.012011	It was moved, seconded, and voted to approve the budget as amended (Onello/Sterling).

STAFFING BOARD

DISCUSSION	In lieu of asking to move the volunteer coordinator from the state grant to the town budget, Julie recommended a new program administrator/coordinator position with an IT component. A town program administrator position at a higher salary already exists so the title might change. This would be a 25 hour/week position, leading to full time. Bill S. recommended that the position be tasked with attracting baby boomers. This would require evening hours. Evelyn pointed out that the town probably got more hours from the job share than it will get from a single director position. Julie will work on the position description for the Personnel Board.
ACTION	It was moved, seconded, and voted to add a 25-hour Coordinator for Senior Activities position o the budget (Yurkofsky/Onello).
