A.Irwin opened the meeting at 7:35 PM noting that a quorum was present.

# 3. Land Management

- a. Farming Agreements
   B.Monahan reported that an email was sent to Dev Hamlen. Follow-up will occur at the next meeting on September 27.
- b. Rice Road Dam B.Monahan reported that the Commission has the breakdown and itemization of \$400-700K worth of work needed at the dam which is to be integrated into a capital budget. A.Irwin commented that \$100K had already been secured for repairs and there is a need to look at cost and prioritization as we put in a capital plan for improvements. Brief discussion ensued of issues, safety and other, to be addressed. A.Irwin commented that the dam is considered to be in "fair" condition vs. poor condition so fortunately we are not in crisis mode.
- 4. 7:40 pm —Continued Public Hearing, Richard and Brenda Sharton, Applicants, 50 Aqueduct Road, DEP File No. 322-776: Notice of Intent filed by Richard and Brenda Sharton pursuant to the Wetlands Protection Act, G.L. ch. 131 s. 40 and the application filed pursuant to Wayland's Wetlands and Water Resources Bylaw, Chapter 194. The application is for hardscape and softscape landscape improvements to the property at 50 Aqueduct Road, Wayland. The proposed work is shown on Wayland's Assessors Map 48, Parcel 087. Applicant recently visited the office to communicate that this item will not be moving forward and will be sending a letter of confirmation along for the file.

A.Irwin confirmed that the Conservation Department had received the letter of withdrawal of the application.

5. 7:41pm – Public Meeting, Raytheon Company, Applicant, 430 Boston Post Road, File D-809. Request for Determination of Applicability filed pursuant to the Wetlands Protection Act, G.L. ch. 131 s. 40 and the application filed pursuant to Wayland's Wetlands and Water Resources Bylaw, Chapter 194 by Raytheon Company. The applicant is proposing to install 4 remediation wells in the 100' buffer zone and interconnect the 4 wells with piping laid in shallow (2'-3') trenching. Work is proposed at 430 (400) Boston Post Road, Wayland MA. The property is shown on Wayland's Assessor's Map 23, Parcels 52 and 52C.

Jason Flattery, Jonathan Hone and Dr. Sami Fam were present for the discussion. Dr. Sami Fam reviewed the plan with the Commission, highlighting the fenced in area and showing areas of remediation. A.Irwin inquired about levels, and Dr. Fam responded that they note 95% improvement where treatment has been done. They are moving from most up gradient to most down gradient and are now proposing to install a sufficient number of wells to deal with the rest of the plume. Dr. Fam reviewed the buffer zone on the plan in relation to the 13 wells – 9 wells outside of the buffer zone and 4 within the buffer zone. The wells will all be interconnected with underground trenching and the fenced in area will be expanded. A.Irwin raised the issue of the Fire Department's concern with methanol in the past. Mr. Hone responded that he had spoken with the Fire Department.

A.Irwin inquired about drilling, and Dr. Fam responded that they will make a stockpile, test it and determine how to proceed based on the results, adding that a staging area will have berm/barrier and be covered at night.

A.Irwin inquired about other matters pending with the existing Notice of Intent asking whether there was a need for extension. Dr. Fam commented that they had tried to close out the file, but the grass was not fully stabilized. He commented that weeds are now quite established and providing that stabilization.

Brief discussion ensued of conditions that would be covered under the Chapter 194 Permit. A.Irwin noted that one condition will be to allow that any damaged well may be repaired promptly for compliance under the MCP. Dr. Fam noted that drilling will start September 24, 2012.

A.Irwin noted a lack of action and mentioned that there had been a percentage holdback as retainage on the project. He would like to communicate that there is noncompliance with the order and we had an event of failure of release/sediment. With construction ongoing, we need confirmation that retainage is being held and will not be released unless and until such time as requirements by the Conservation Commission are satisfied concerning corrective action on the issues. B.Monahan will communicate to F.Turkington and J.Moynihan that A.Irwin would like to meet with the committee. Discussion ensued on how to proceed with lack of response. Commission of the property which had previously come before the Commission with an application for a septic system repair. Perry Beckett said he was repairing a septic system that actually was determined by the Commission to be an upgrade, so the Commission issued a positive determination which required filing of a Notice of Intent before upgrade work could proceed. Now a neighbor reports a septic system is being installed, and the Board of Health is not aware of any project being approved at the property.

# b. October Special Town Meeting

B.Monahan explained that the warrant is closed for October. A.Irwin asked how many properties we want to include at the subsequent town meeting in the spring. B.Howell requested that one item be Pinebrook along with Lower Millbrook access. B.Monahan asked that consideration be given to purchasing the entire parcel on Lundy Lane on the side of the cluster. It would provide uplands access and would be appraised as a house lot. B.Monahan and M.Burke will do a site visit.

# c. Comments on the Habitat for Humanity Housing

A.Irwin recused himself from this agenda item due to a conflict of interest and departed the meeting at 8:50pm.

B.Monahan shared that the Commission should ask the Board of Appeals for drainage mitigation and sediment erosion control during construction. L.Kiernan asked if this was town land, and B.Monahan responded that it is and that it qualifies for a 40B comprehensive housing permit. B.Monahan showed the plan to Commissioners and commented that the Commission would ask the Board of Appeals to regulate Chapter 193.

Motion to authorize B.Monahan to send a letter to the Board of Appeals to enforce C.193 and request specific attention to matters of sediment erosion control, drainage and BMPs during construction; Seconded 5-0
