Minutes: Assembled from notes taken at meeting due to absence of minute-taker.

A.Irwin opened the meeting at 7:32 PM noting that a quorum was present.

7:30 pm – Citizens Time
 No comments were offered.

2. Minutes - March 20, 2014 and April 10, 2014

Motion to approve the Minutes of March 20, 2014 as edited; Seconded 6-0 Motion to approve the Minutes of April 10, 2014; Seconded 6-0

- 3. Review of River Trail Place Submissions (DEP File 322-816)
 - a. Trail Easement
 Discussion runs east/west make sure it is on Brendon Homes property. There is a letter that notes the easement. Questions were raised about permitting snow shoes and skis on the trail.
 - Soil Management and Dewatering Proposal
 A statement was made that a "smell test" won't work under construction general permit; one can dewater but we need VOC tests to show presence or absence. Soils going off site would have to be on bill of lading manifest. This should not be a guiding principle. We have EPA notice.
 Applicant was informed about O&M plans and asked to note deviations on inspection reports.
- 4. Request for Certificate of Compliance [310 CMR 10.05 (9)]
 - a. Wayland Commons; DEP File 322-624
 Brian Card of Brendon Homes and Vito Colonna of Sullivan, Connors were present.
 Discussion ensued on the Certificate of Compliance submission dated February 14, 2014, with particular mention of items 7 and 8. Storm Basin 1 was built before others took over construction. There is an increase in the design. The 2 and 10 year was below and the 100 year was above and 100 year being above is allowed by the State if there is no offsite impact as this was a 40B project under the Wetland Protection Act only. The Commission asked Mr. Colonna to address how changes relate to pre-construction. Item 9 was discussed. The Commission requested clarification on items 7 and 8 and noted that filing of an amendment may be in order for number 9.
 - 55 Knollwood; File D-818
 Discussion is tabled until the next meeting to allow for a site inspection.
 - c. Town Center On-site work; DEP File 322-701

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Discussion ensued resulting in action to contact Mr. Dougherty and suggest that the Certificate of Compliance Request be withdrawn based on remaining issues relative to trail easement, Conservation Restriction and amendments for all of the minor deviations outlined.

B.Goldsmith reported on an informal meeting with David Faist, Frank Dougherty, Bob Griffin, Roger Backman, and Brian Monahan to discuss the requested certificate of compliance and return of deposit for the on-site TC project.

B.Goldsmith noted that the originally approved drainage drawing has a drain line to the Town Parcel (stub), including two BMPs, but not shown in the as-built plan.

Discussion ensued about the missing drainage connection to the Municipal Parcel. Also, it was noted that the land owner must tell us who is managing the O&M Plan.

B.Goldsmith noted transfer of ownership. Transfer of land needs to be communicated per condition #53. Discussed matters with M.Lanza who came to meeting. Matters relating to the on-site decision include evaluating the revised O&M to assure that it identifies land owner and who is responsible for tasks, updating any comments in response to David Faist including ascertaining if the fence at the southeastern corner of the property is fixed and communicating issues and concerns to Mike Abell when it might apply to the SOC. There was a discussion of how to process outstanding items such as the drainage components that have not been installed.

5. Land Management

a. Lincoln Road

M.Lanza presented the Conservation Restriction and discussed status. M.Lanza asked for authority to correct any clerical errors.

Motion to accept the Conservation Restriction as presented and permit Town Counsel to make any clerical changes and immediately notify the Conservation Commission of any clerical changes; Seconded 6-0

- b. Gift for Cow Common was mentioned.
- c. Improvements to Heard Farm and Loker Recreation and Conservation Areas with funds from approved FY15 capital budget
 Discussed Loker and Heard Farm – subgrade and drainage conditions; DPW can do test pits.
- d. Linda Segal noted kiosk and trail head and signs needed for Loker Conservation Area.
- e. Rocky Point Land

Discussion needed with M.Lanza as to how to the care and custody shifting to the Conservation Commission.

Motion to name the area Rocky Point Conservation Land; Seconded 6-0

- f. Other Brief discussion ensued on dog walkers due to recent assault at Loker.
- g. Other Discussion on outstanding Conservation contributions of four individuals and presentation of Ken Moon awards

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Motion to recognize Nicky Patterson and Mats Borgestedt for 2013 (Heard); Seconded 6-0 Motion to recognize Bill Green (Heard orchard) and John Hines (birding) for 2014; Seconded 6-0

6. Other

- a. Chapter 193 Update: Regulations and possible changes to consider The need to do the regulations first was discussed along with drainage and the need to consider changes to lower the threshold requiring review.
- b. Floodplain Map Changes and Changes needed for Chapter 194 Bylaw and Regulations It was noted that current regulations must reference the latest floodplain map.
- c. MACC Handbook one in office and can pay for two additional.
- d. Status of the Landfill Roadway Appeal and Funding for Mitigation Process – discharge under the Wetlands Protection Act; discussed drainage and connections. Designate Conservation approval for non-stormwater discharges under MS4. DPW has responsibility for the drains under MS4 and there is a need for the Commission and DPW to work together. The Commission can issue tickets for unpermitted illicit discharge.
- e. There was a discussion of connecting sump pumps to the town's stormwater drains.

7. Compliance Updates - 25 Millbrook Road

B.Monahan noted that the homeowner was notified twice by letter. Storm drain in the road is higher so it is not functioning and rills are forming. Parking in the buffer zone was noted.

8. Other

Linda Segal spoke about the sand and gravel PIP in Framingham. It was noted that Richard Turner also attended the meeting.
