S. Greenbaum opened the meeting at 7:20PM noting that a quorum was present.

1. 7:20 PM – Citizens Time: This is a time for input to the Commission regarding items that are *not* on the agenda.

No comments were offered

2. 7:40 - Continued Public Hearing, Kevin O'Leary, P.E., The Jillson Company, Applicant, 15, 17, and 21 Training Field Road, DEP File No. 322-874: B. Monahan discussed P. Fletcher's draft report and gave two copies to K. O'Leary. P. Fletcher is requesting the actual plan and K. O'Leary said he will give that to him. .S. Greenbaum stated that she researched the BOH records and that there are at least 24 private wells within a half-mile of the proposed project. B. Monahan noted that some plans showed Goddard flagging with Peter Fletcher's flagging but the location of the wetlands under Chap. 194 needs to be delineated. The conservation cluster on 8.7 acres includes two proposed houses. The Commission traditionally seeks a deed transfer to protect the open space. The applicant prefers a deed restriction only. They will meet with Planning on 1/3/17.

## 3. 6 Brook Trail Road, DEP File No. 322-315

The deed restriction was originally discussed on November 3, 2016 with Norton and Ellen Feldman, homeowners. Town Counsel made revisions and it is now ready to sign.

Motion to accept the deed restriction for 6 Brook Trail Road; Seconded 5-0.

There was informal discussion of a plan to apply for a deck and hot tub in the future. The Commission discussed its preference that any hot tub be environmentally sensitive to its potential location near the restricted area. The homeowners were encouraged to research options and submit an application when they were ready.
