Discussion was as follows:

1) Public comment

Jean Milburn, prospective EDC member, was introduced and attended the meeting. Other guests indicated that they were interested in Rt 20 housing and Finnerty's topics.

2) Approve meeting minutes

 - a) New EDC members

Jean Milburn and Rick Olstein are recommended by EDC as two new members. Jean has served on the Master Plan 5-Year Advisory Committee and on the committee which drafted the Design Review Guidelines, and brings a business background to the EDC. Rick Olstein is a local developer with Keystone Development, and brings expertise to the EDC on a host of issues, from general development to solar. Both have attended EDC meetings, and have a good understanding of the scope of the EDC. It was agreed that Ms. Stanizzi would send a recommendation to the BOS to get the process moving.

b) Administrative assistant update

4) EDC Priorities

- a) Route 20 Septage Facility / DPW Site senior housing proposal
 - i) Market Study preliminary results

This topic was discussed at length at prior meetings, therefore discussion this week was brief. Review of "one-pager" summary is awaiting final market study.

ii) Environmental Phase I and follow-up – summarize results

Mr. Potter drafted and circulated a draft summary which was reviewed and discussed as the primary topic of this EDC meeting. Comments were suggested, questions were added, and Mr. Potter will update. [See EDC website or BOS meeting minutes for final version.]

One question arose regarding the issue of methane smells which sometimes are smelled, under certain wind patterns, at Longfellow and the office buildings immediately adjacent to the Sudbury landfill. (It was noted that these smells have declined substantially now that the Sudbury landfill has been capped for a number of years, but still may be an issue). Mr. Potter to research with Tighe& Bond.

iii) Outreach

Next BOS meeting is late Sept. It was suggested to hold a separate meeting so that Q&A could occur and not bog down typical BOS business. Mr. Potter to coordinate.

iv) Next steps
