### **Streetlights**

Ellen and Anne reported on meeting regarding streetlights with John Moynihan and John Bladon on 5/14/12. In that meeting:

- John Bladon expressed interest in presenting the draft streetlight conversion worksheet to the Selectmen.
- John Moynihan expressed preliminary interest in purchasing the lights and upgrading to high pressure sodium or LED.
- John Moynihan will obtain a copy of the maintenance contract from Sudbury or Weston.

At tonight's meeting the Committee discussed lighting options. Before any conversion, it would be helpful to test options, direct the public to look at examples, and hold hearings to educate the public. The high school parking lot would be a good example for LED, HPS already installed in several locations.

The Committee also discussed whether it would be realistic to purchase the lights and replace as they burned out, but suspected it would be more cost effective to replace all at once.

Action items:

Anne will contact Helen AKI at MAPC regarding the regional LED purchase; what towns are doing or have done LED? What types are being selected? Is there performance data?  
Anne will join MMEG (Mass Municipal Energy Group) online forum to see if there is helpful info on LED lights.

### **Mass Energy Insight**

The Committee spent some time reviewing the MassEnergyInsight reports. The program feels cumbersome; a helpful feature would be a flag that alerts to energy anomalies. We did note the energy use looks high at the Loker school and should be followed up on.

Action items:

Anne will contact Pat and John Moynihan to mention Loker energy use.
