WHC hasn't heard back from the Sudbury Historical Commission regarding the bronze plaque from the septage facility.

6. Historic Homes Update: (Elisa)

Elisa asked for approval to spend \$75 to fix/replace the broken "No Parking" sign. Approved

7. New business and other items not identified prior to submission of the agenda:

Sheila has price/info on camera for WHC to use for documentation. Mike Lowery mentioned that the DPW has tablets they use that have software to document GPS, pipe locations, etc.

WHC does not want to get involved with monthly software payments. Mike also mentioned the site ISSUU that some town departments are using. Sheila to find out how to procure items.

- -Mike Lowery received information regarding a talk on the Public Bath Movement, April  $16^{th}$  at 10:30~AM
- -Mike also mentioned that the DCR has a Historical Curatorship program with some funding. Lake Cochituate Gate House has applied. Mike talked about the Metropolitan Waterworks Museum, and the Lake Cochituate water system that provided water to Boston through a series of reservoirs.
