Operations Review Committee (OCR) – Draft Report (part 2)

JS reported on the Abrahams Group's draft report regarding enhanced utilization of MUNIS, sharing Finance Department staff with the School Department, potentially contracting-out work for cafeteria and custodial services and consolidating Town and

School IT operations. The report is quite lengthy so the path to the draft report on the Town's website was provided to the Board. While many of the Abrahams' recommendations would likely improve reporting, some recommendations could be problematic if MUNIS system changes were not implemented. Decentralizing time and attendance is one such example. The ORC is scheduled to meet again on 3/31. JS expected at least one further meeting for the ORC to finalize their recommendations.

Executive Session:

NM declared that the Board should move into executive session to discuss strategy with respect to collective bargaining as a discussion in an open meeting may have a detrimental effect on the Town's negotiating position.

MP made a motion to move into Executive Session for the purpose of discussing collective bargaining strategy with the AFSCME, Library, Fire, SEIU and DPW unions as conducting such business in Open Session will have a detrimental effect on the Board's negotiating position. PS seconded the motion.
