JS reviewed a draft proposal to combine Highway and Parks operations. Phase 1 of the proposal would eliminate the 2 current Superintendent positions and create 1 new Superintendent and 1 Asst. Superintendent. Both existing Superintendent positions are affiliated with AFSCME. Phase 2 of the proposal would eliminate the Sr. Foreman's position and create a new Working Foreman's position. The foremen positions are part of the Teamsters bargaining unit. The Board discussed the perceived and practical impact of the proposed changes. Questions were posed regarding the role of the BOPW. JS stated that the BOPW was a policy board and that operational decisions were vested with the Town Administrator, but if this proposal moves forward, the intent is to present the proposal to the BOPW in executive session for their comment and feedback.

Step 3 SEIU/ Grievance:

JS reviewed the Step 3 grievance decision by the BOS. The union has 30 days by contract if it opts to pursue arbitration.
