# Community Input Meeting

## TOWN OF WAYLAND

### Dudley Woods Walking Trails

Wayland residents are invited to attend a public input meeting hosted by staff representing the Recreation Commission. The meeting is being held to update residents and gather input about the Dudley Woods Walking Trails project that is currently underway.

The Dudley Woods Walking Trails project proposes constructing ADA accessible walking trails through the town-owned parcels of land known as “Dudley Woods” located off of Pond Drive near Dudley Pond. The Recreation Commission has consulted with “Marshall Gary” to develop a preliminary site plan for the trail. Currently, the proposed trail is approx. 1/3 mile in length, with three entrances, and is designed to curve to conform to the natural contours of the site so limit extensive grading. The width of the trail is 5 feet and proposed to be paved with porous pavement or dense crushed stone. The trail is also designed to minimize disturbance of the “avoidance area” and completely avoids the “points of interest” designated in the Technical report: ‘*Ceremonial Stone Landscape Survey*’ by CLR dated December 30, 2015 that was led by the Historic Commission. Interpretive signage will be designed and placed on the trail to describe the history of the land, vegetation and wildlife.

#### ***YOUR OPINION COUNTS!***

At the meeting, Marshall Gary (the Town’s consultant) will describe the proposed trails in more detail and hope to gather thoughts and feedback on the preliminary design. Community input is essential in order to develop a plan that best meets Wayland’s needs.
