Former State Representative John (Jack) Flood attended our meeting to discuss the background of the tax relief bill of 1987. This bill was proposed following Proposition 2½, at a time when taxes were being re-evaluated. House values were going up, but income for seniors was not. This bill was meant to help elderly middle class people stay in their homes. It was drafted for middle class incomes and assets at the time (not poverty level). Our committee discussed adjusting the statutory amounts of income and assets to bring them up to current middle class income and asset values. In addition our committee then discussed an index to automatically increase the limits when we write our proposal.

Minutes of the October 9th meeting of the committee were read and approved as written.

Julie and Rebecca will be submitting the annual report for our committee to the town for its town wide publication.

Pat Nelson informed us that she would be resigning from the committee at the end of the meeting after many years of service.
