SENIOR TAX RELIEF COMMITTEE August 14, 2013

The meeting was called to order at 8:00 AM.

There was no public comment.

There are presently 9 members assigned to our committee which requires a quorum of 5 for any votes that need to be taken. We unanimously voted to request that the Board of Selectmen lower the number of members to 7 which would require a quorum of 4. We should have that done by our next meeting. Rebecca was also going to ask what the duties of the members are to the boards that we are assigned to represent.

We discussed the fliers for tax relief information that Don Bustin had presented at our last meeting. We are hoping to get approval on the information on these fliers by October.

Steve Colella reported on the research that he had done about the tax relief laws, the changes that have been made to eligibility requirements for real estate tax relief, and the way the Circuit Breaker tax credit is adjusted annually by a cost of living factor. We will continue to work on a letter to our state representatives to ask that other tax relief be increased and then be adjusted annually.
