Minutes of Wayland SWQC Meeting, 6 October, 2011

- 1. The meeting came to order at 7:30 PM. There was no public comment.
- 2. Minutes of the previous meeting were approved 3-0.
- 3. Dudley Pond
 - a. *E. Coli* Measurements program ended at the end of August. Results were presented in the last meeting's minutes.
 - b. 123 Dudley Rd. Cesspool is still being pumped, with no progress on installation of a treatment system.
 - c. Circulator Status. Two are in winter storage; third will be soon. Repairs will be made at Mike's home after ice forms and provides ready access.
 - d. Milfoil Pulling Status. As of the end of September, 8,500 weeds had been hand pulled. Allison is still pulling and finding both smaller and larger plants in deeper water, some with large root balls. See chart for cumulative plants pulled. The plants are concentrated at stormwater outfall pipes, indicating importance of the stormwater nutrient load.
- 4. Heard Pond. No discussion due to Tom Largy's absence.
- 5. North Pond Lake Cochituate.
 - a. Milfoil fragment capture at the net at the entrance to North Pond has shown substantial weed capture. See attached graph, prepared by Lin. Amount captured is directly related to water flow rate under Route 30 bridge.
 - b. Mike to contact DCR about a cost-shared program repeat for 2012. Expect proposals to be due in November.
- 6. Old Business. The progress of the Dudley Area Advisory Committee was reviewed.
- 7. New Business. Voted 3-0 to continue COLAP membership.
- 8. Invoice Approval. Approved two small invoices for *E. Coli* assays.
- 9. Adjournment at 8:30 voted 3-0.
