Minutes of Wayland SWQC 21 March, 2012 Meeting

The meeting came to order at 7:30 PM. There was no public comment.

- 1. Minutes of the previous meeting were approved 4-0
- 2. Heard Pond.
 - a. We are awaiting ConCom's extension of the current 3-yr Order of Conditions, which has been extended by the State to 5 yrs.
- 3. Dudley Pond.
 - a. Bob reviewed the EPA presentation at the DEP Circuit Rider forum in Concord on 20 March. Briefly, no NOI is required if the <u>area of application</u> is fewer than 80 acres. More than one application per year is allowed without any change in the area of application. Further, possible spread of a pesticide (herbicide) beyond the area of application does not increase the area of application. The applicator must comply with EPA's generic 5-yr permit, which has no change from current practices followed by licensed contractors in the State.
 - b. Mike sent a letter to the Chateau asking them to clean debris on their property proximate the pond.
 - c. Bob reviewed the current status of the Doran Road Activity Committee proceedings.
 - d. The Committee approved the sale and removal of the circulators to the original supplier at a price of \$3,000 (or more). Vote was 4-0
- 4. North Pond.
 - a. The Committee approved, 4-0, purchase by Lin of the materials needed to repair the capture net at the entrance to North Pond from Middle Pond.
- 5. Toni interviewed a high school student (junior) who is interested in being an intern for the summer. The Committee voted to do so at an hourly rate of \$10/hr.
- 6. Article 6 in the Town Warrant was discussed, and the Committee voted (3-0) to oppose it as funds are expected be requested in the future to make stormwater treatment improvements at Dudley Pond, and CPA funding would be sought. The Committee also voted 3-0 to state the Committee's opposition.
- 7. The committee voted 5-0 to adjourn at about 8:30 PM.
