MINUTES

1. The meeting came to order at 7:30 PM.

- 2. Minutes of the November 19th, 2013 meeting were approved, 5-0.
- 3. Public Comments. None
- 4. Dudley Pond.
 - a. The Board of Public Works voted Dudley Point as surplus land and transfer to ConCom
 - b. Invoices were approved for ACT for \$2,520.35 and \$400 and Nashoba Analytical Lab for \$1,539 by a vote of 5-0.
 - c. The year-end ConCom report is due and Mike will prepare.
 - d. Contract(s) will be let for hand pulling milfoil 2014. As the contract will be on an hourly cost basis but likely exceed \$5,000, it will be bid and awarded competitively (Mike to handle).
 - e. A contract will be bid competitively and let for spot treatment with triclopyr in 2014 (Mike to handle).
- 5. Heard Pond.
 - a. The year-end ConCom report is due and Tom will prepare.
 - b. A \$4,900 not-to-exceed contract will be let to Lycott for water chestnut harvesting in 2014 (Tom to handle)
- 6. North Pond. Mike will continue to contact DCR about the status of the proposed cost shared program for 2014. An announcement on proposals selected for funding was promised shortly.
- 7. Mill Pond. A discussion was held about possible work for Mill Pond. Limitations of funding in FY15 may require this be done in FY16.
