- 1. Acceptance of the wastewater pump station and appurtenant work Wayland indicated that it would be provided in December 2012.
- 2. Provide as-built plans upon completion of the New Plant. The plant was completed on November 7, 2012;
- 3. Record Final Wastewater System Easement Plan within 60 days of completing construction. This was due January 7, 2013;
- 4. Provide Developer with a draft plan within 30 days of recording final documents. This was due by December 7, 2012;
- 5. Demolish the existing facilities including all improvements from Parcel A; remove the utility services to the Existing Plant; remove the Existing Outfall Pipe; restore Parcel A, water service pipe area, and Existing Outfall Pipe Area. When will this be complete?;
- 6. Convey clear title to Parcel A; When will this be complete?
- 7. Abandon all rights to existing easements; When will this be complete?
- 8. Take by eminent domain the Pump Station Facilities. This was due by November 23, 2012;
- 9. Prepare a Final Wastewater System Easement Plan. This was due by November 23, 2012; and
- 10. Reimburse the Developer \$25,000 for compensation associated with the Pump Station Facilities. This was due by November 23, 2012.




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### Daily & Monthly Flow Over July 2009-Dec2012




### **New WWTF: Initial Daily Flow**
