Birch Rd. Wells FEIR MEPA Comment Letter: Deadline is Friday, Oct. 23. WPC discussed final draft. Will attach color-coded GIS map showing Framingham Zone II extending into Wayland, with courtesy copies sent to same recipients as DEIR comment letter. Voted 4-0 to approve and submit WPC comment letter to MEPA office (T. Sciacca motion, J. Riley second).

Correspondence: Discussed whether or not to respond to call for action on Governor's new policy that threatens to weaken river protection, e.g. leaving safe yield to be redefined by a judge. Mass Rivers Alliance seeks organizations to sign on. Consensus that organizations are distinct from governmental bodies; individuals can send their personal comments to the Globe, Governor's office, etc.

Miscellaneous update: S. Greenbaum reported that we're still waiting to hear from DEP's Sarafinas. WPC should be in the Annual Report. Baldwin Open House still on for Nov. 14. T. Sciacca to invite WHA chair Mary Antes to our next meeting to discuss sand pit parcel. All boards are posted for Monday, October 19 FinCom FY11 budget guidelines hearing.
