FY 14 Budget

• Town Meeting passed the Omnibus budget last night, making no changes to the WYFS budget as proposed. However, WaylandCares budget was eliminated completely, which will be a loss of service to the community if the grant funding is not renewed.

Board Updates and Discussion

- Mr. Jim Forti announced his resignation from the YAC, effective 4/15/13, due to the need to change his residency to New Hampshire. He will be ineligible to serve on the YAC, so the need arises to elect a new chair and to recruit a new board member.
- Internet safety and expanding access among young children discussed as a growing concern. A discussion ensued about how to educate parents so that they are knowledgeable in how to place limits on social media. Officer Mark Wilkins of the WPD was suggested as a possible resource.
- Concerns about kids' access to inappropriate electronic content were discussed, as well as ways that parents can work together to create guidelines and manage this issue and those that arise later in adolescence.
