We need to go through Rex when contracting. Paul S. suggested looking at the website of Commpass under Massachusetts Procurement for vendors that we would not need a RFP.

Maggie Downey will be asked to do a presentation at our next meeting about their conservation project for residences.

Jim Sexton has asked to resign as representative to Cape Light Compact. The committee discussed the position and voted to recommend that the selectmen appoint Bill as the representative and Kathy as the alternate. Dick stated that he would communicate our recommendation to the selectmen.

There was a discussion of the new Open Meeting Law and all were asked to attend the training session 6/30/10 at the COA either at 2 pm or 6 pm.

Dick discussed having a blog that all our e mails would pass through and then be open to the world.

Paul Banner will look into the estimated price of energy bought and sold by Cape Wind to the National Grid.
