

Cemetery Commissioners
Minutes
March 20, 2001

The meeting was called to order by Sue Albee, chairperson at 1:35 p.m. Those present included Dawn E. Rickman and Virginia Crossman.

A motion was made to recommend Article 16 for the Annual Town Meeting for acceptance of Perpetual Care monies for the South Wellfleet Cemetery. Passed unanimously.

A motion was made to transfer the sum of \$10,000 as of July 1, 2001 from the Perpetual Care Income fund to the DPW salaries and wages for Cemetery seasonal workers. Passed unanimously.

A motion was made to transfer the sum of \$125.00 from the Perpetual Care Income fund to pay for 2 Mylar maps of Pleasant Hill Cemetery. Passed unanimously.


Virginia suggested that the Town vote to accept the water hand pump donated to the Wellfleet Cemetery.

Dawn indicated that the Commissioners should revise and amend the Cemetery Rules and Regulations, as there appears to be several areas of concern. Sue said that it would be brought up at the next meeting in May.

Sue related that Paul Fox from the Historical Commission was looking into applying for a grant in order to repair tombstones at the Duck Creek Cemetery.

There being no further business a motion to adjourn was passed unanimously at 2:13 p.m.
