The meeting was opened at 9:04 a.m. with Dawn E. Rickman, Barbara Cormier and Betsy Patterson present. Mrs. Elizabeth Taute was in the audience. The Board reorganized as follows:

Barbara Cormier nominated and elected chairperson; Dawn Rickman nominated and elected secretary.

Dawn explained the accounts and procedures for plot purchase and investment.


Barbara brought up the matter of a private cemetery at Sandpiper Hill (Barrio?) and whether or not the Town maintained the same. The matter would be looked into.

Barbara indicated that the South Wellfleet Cemetery is in need of Perpetual Care markers. Dawn told her to go to Oakdale Cemetery and take as many as needed.

At this time Elizabeth Taute was recognized. She brought the matter of her son's property abutting the Cemetery and the recent Town Meeting article where undersized lots are not considered as buildable. She wondered if the Town might either sell a parcel of Town property to her son or buy her son's property. Dawn related that the Department of Environmental Protection may have a problem with residential water in the cemetery boundaries, and other options may have to be looked into.
