Members present: Thomas Flynn, Chairman, Sylvia Smith, Thomas Peters (clerk); absent, Clarence Smith.

The Chairman called the meeting to order at 7:40 PM.

1. The members first considered and subsequently approved unanimously a letter of appreciation for Robert Paine. The clerk is directed to transmit the same.
2. The members considered and revised the draft minutes for the meeting of Sept. 10; and as revised approved the same unanimously.

#### OLD BUSINESS

1. After the site visit to the "Gut" in July, T. Flynn wrote a letter to Ms. Beebe, Health and Conservation Agent for Wellfleet. The letter forwarded this Committee's recommendations for the grant application. T. Flynn will follow up on the grant application and program it encompasses.
2. Fresh Water RFP. The Committee senses that this topic is at best in the outer periphery of its charter and defers to other boards and committees.
3. The Selectmen have read T. Flynn's memo to rename LANDINGS as "Town ways to water." Most like the rationale and express that it would ameliorate conflicts, confusion and misunderstandings.
4. New Members. The Selectmen have the Committee's memo. There has been no action. Accordingly the Committee needs to take the initiative.

#### NEW BUSINESS

1. Next Meeting. Nov. 12, 2002 at the Council on Aging @ 7:30 PM.
2. General discussion of Town landing due West of Eastham/Wellfleet town line, via Parkington Hill Road. The topic raises issues with the Audubon Society.
3. General discussion of Fisherman's Landing. Issues with the National Park Service.
4. The committee discussed the need for it to smooth out its site plan evaluations in anticipation of the proposed survey and inventory of all town roads, property and accesses to water.
5. The committee plans a work session this Friday in the Assessor's office.
