Request for Town Funding

Members unanimously voted to pursue town funding. (9 Yes, 0 No) Ms. Carroll will draft the request.

FY2011 Funds Available for Granting

Members reviewed account balances, pending expenditures, and discretional spending options from locally raised funds.

Members voted to terminate unused FY2010 grants totaling \$600 (Preservation Hall \$350; Cape Cod Chamber Music Festival \$250), and re-grant these funds in FY2011. (8 Yes, 1 Recused)

Members voted to set aside 5% of the FY2011 state allocation for administrative funds, as permitted under Local Cultural Council (LCC) program guidelines. (9 Yes, 0 No)

Members voted to grant \$843.36 from locally raised funds. (9 Yes, 0 No)

Academy of Performing Arts: Holiday/Spring student production

(9 Yes, 0 No) Proposed project did not provide adequate public benefit to our community compared with other proposals we received. Applicant did not have support of a local venue.

Truro Center for the Arts at Castle Hill: Scholarships for Wellfleet residents

(9 Yes, 0 No) Proposed project did not provide adequate public benefit for our community compared with other proposals we received.

Paul Bouchard: Big Band Bennie Goodman concert

(9 Yes, 0 No) Applicant did not have support of a local venue; Council choose to support applicants who did not rely on the Wellfleet Cultural Council as their sole source of funding; Council chose to support more local applicants.

Edward M. Wirt: Briefcase Full of Blues concert

(9 Yes, 0 No) Applicant did not have support of a local venue; Council choose to support applicants who did not rely on the Wellfleet Cultural Council as their sole source of funding; Council chose to support more local applicants; Applicant failed to explain how partial funding would impact the presentation of the project.

Cultural Center of Cape Cod: RISE AND SHINE Program for at-risk youth

(9 Yes, 0 No) Proposed project did not provide adequate public benefit to our community compared with other proposals we received. Applicant did not have support of a local venue.
