Board of Selectmen January 12, 1994 Minutes

The meeting was called to order at 4:15 p.m. by Chairwoman Carolina Kiggins. Present were Selectmen Barbara Fegan, Robert S. Costa, John Ryerson, David Ernst and Town Administrator, Julia Enroth. Also attending was Jim MacLachlan, Finance Committee liaison.

After some discussion, the Board voted on a motion duly made and seconded to approve the use of the town basketball court for ice skating under certain conditions and with a reference on the permission form denoting the Town's liability insurance coverage.

Assessor Ray Squire met with the Board to discuss his request for \$4785 for an ongoing annual revaluation data update program to replace a major update program each nine years. This approach has been recommended by the Department of Revenue and the Board agreed with the Assessor and Town Administrator that it would be worthwhile. Therefore, the Board voted unanimously to accept the Town Administrator's recommendation and adopt the Assessors' budget as follows:

#141 Assessing Dept. \$ 66,843 with separate line item of \$4,875 for ongoing revaluation program

After an explanation of several items from the Town Administrator, the Board voted to also accept the Town Administrator's recommendation on Shellfish Conservation and Propagation and adopt the following budget:

#180 Shellfish Cons/Prop \$ 19,730

Continuing with its budget review the Board voted to accept the Town Administrator's recommendation and adopt the following budgets:
